
Elementary Scope and Sequence 2024-2025

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About the GO! Elementary Scope and Sequence:

The GO! Scope and Sequence covers a total of 3 years. Each year begins in August and takes kids on a chronological journey through the entire Bible with different stories and with a different emphasis. During the this ministry year, kids will see and experience both God’s power and promises through the Big Bible Story, but there will be a special emphasis on God’s people. God’s story of grace and redemption through His

Son, Jesus, is told both to people and through people. Kids will discover that God has invited them to be His people and to share His story with the world. There will be glimpses of God’s salvation plan throughout the year, but there will be four lessons where that plan is communicated clearly and kids will have an opportunity to respond. WHAT'S NEXT?



PICTURE THIS


